**ATR VERDICT:** Bob Pebble enjoyed a solid first spin when third in a bumper here on UK/stable debut last month and should appreciate this extra yardage now hurdling, but TEMPLEPARK sets a high standard for this time of year and is fancied to defy a penalty for Fergal O'Brien. The seven-year-old is better known for his exploits over fences, but won cosily here by nine lengths over the smaller obstacles last time and appears poised to go in again. Noble Behest is rated 75 on the level and could take third.

**ATR VERDICT:** HICONIC carries a triple penalty after three quick successes but should be helped by Bryan Carver's 5lb claim here. The three-year-old's sequence started here a month ago and he has since followed up easily at Bangor-on-Dee and Stratford. A decent surface appears imperative to him, and he would be hard to beat if running to his official rating of 119. Pink Jazz was third behind the selection at Stratford on his hurdling debut and could get closer this time, while Highlander Madrik was a solid Flat horse in France and is intriguing now with David Pipe.
