ATR VERDICT: Rose To Fame has won her last two starts but has a lengthy absence to overcome, similarly Sid Hoodie, who has landed two of her last three but returns from a 276-day layoff. The one that makes most appeal is SEE THE SEA, who represents the same trainer/jockey combination that won this contest 12 months ago. The six-year-old ran well on her only previous visit here and two recent runs (one in this sphere and one on the Flat) should have put her spot on for this.
