Zoom Call was no match for Miss Amulet inside the final furlong of a Cork maiden but the form received a timely boost when the winner took that aforementioned Naas Listed race in good style on Monday. Jessica Harrington has a good line on form with nine juvenile winners already this term and her Bell I Am looks a lively threat, while Shambara, Betrayed and Omakase are others that could progress.

ATR VERDICT: Johnny Murtagh's yard continues in good form and REVOLUTME may provide the Curragh trainer with another success. It will be interesting to see if the runner-up at Cork, Zoom Call, can give the form another boost in the opener on this card. Zoffany's Delight showed promise in maidens at the Curragh and Naas and is now fitted with cheek pieces after never getting involved following a tardy start last time. Mass Gathering was soundly beaten at the Curragh on her latest outing but previously showed some pace at Limerick.

ATR VERDICT: Due to be represented by Fiadhna at this venue in a mares maiden hurdle on Wednesday, Andrew Kinirons is set to have his first Flat runner here as Briseuse De Coeur does battle under Scott McCullagh. Former holder of the licence at Ladytown Stud, Madeleine Tylicki is "taking a step back." However "it's business as usual and all the horses will be staying here," said the Newbridge-based woman recently, and for Kilkenny owner/breeders, the Fitzpatricks, Briseuse De Coeur has a squeak, though a wide draw in stall thirteen doesn't inspire confidence. Settle Me Down and Dame Rapide are other runners to start off for new handlers now, but for a selection EARLS is taken to reverse Down Royal form with Misterio. Eddie Lynam's representative has fared better on the draw and that could prove crucial.

ATR VERDICT: From a local stable in red-hot form the chances of course winner SICARIO have to be taken very seriously. Sicario is up nine pounds. The form is good though and the five-year-old is still at the right end of the weights. As previous Sligo victors, Mick Mulvany's pair, Ideal Pal and In From The Cold, need respecting.

ATR VERDICT: COBB AND CO could make it 13th time lucky and shed his maiden tag, returning to action quickly after finishing fifth at Galway on Sunday. Like many that struggle to put a win on the board, the selection probably lacks a change of gear, and to that end an extended ten furlongs at a track with a stiff finish like here, could be just what the doctor ordered. At a mark of 64 with Donagh O'Connor up to claim the three, the grey should be bang there despite his top weight impost. In truth cases can be made for plenty of these and as the only one of them with success to their name, Scholastic would be a major contender if getting her opportunity from a first reserve position. Otherwise the likes of Sienna Lady, Ivy Avenue and Philly's Hope will be on all short lists.

However one just gets the impression that she'll be progressive enough to cope, and going further in trip ought to play to her strengths. Handicap first-timer Red Line Alexander is among the dangers. Plenty of these would seem to have the potential to have a say though.

ATR VERDICT: ARCLAND doesn't really give himself a chance by racing on the keen side. Oisin Orr is the latest man charged with the task of getting him to switch off and perhaps he'll manage it. There's surely more than one win in Harry Rogers' charge if he could just gain the confidence of a breakthrough success. The selection is also entered at Leopardstown on Thursday. After her win over hurdles at Galway, Loudest Whisper (in here over hurdles on Wednesday) will justifiably have her backers and she should be there or thereabouts. Dashing Diamond really took the eye with her finishing effort at Killarney. Blinkers now replace cheek-pieces and she's not one to dismiss too lightly. Universal Focus and Amlad could definitely come into it whilst Shane Duffy (Molly Kaye and Border Battle) and John McConnell (Cash In Mind, Cherryville and Karashala) have weight of numbers in their respective favour.
