ATR VERDICT: Line Of Departure built on a near miss at Newbury when getting off the mark on his first outing in this sphere at Yarmouth last time. He should be thereabouts once again despite a 5lb rise, but preference goes to JADWAL, who took a huge step forward when scoring on his second start at Newmarket. He bounced off the quick ground on that occasion and there is no reason to doubt he could follow that impressive success up here. Et Tu Brute was second in that contest and is respected, while Ripon winner Ataser also warrants consideration, despite this appearing tougher.

ATR VERDICT: Course-and-distance winner EQUITATION has a fine record at this venue and is backed to go one better than his second over 5f here last month off just a 1lb higher mark. Theotherside made it two wins from her last three when getting the better of Will To Win (second) at Windsor, but was hit with a 7lb rise for that which makes life tougher, and gives Simon & Ed Walker's gelding the chance to reverse the finishing order. Highland Dress has remained competitive in some hot events since scoring at Newmarket in June, while Chil Chil caught the eye when second on his reappearance at Windsor and could take advantage of the same rating.

ATR VERDICT: In a competitive contest the marginal preference is for KALOOR, who did not get the clearest of runs when third at Sandown over 1m6f last time. That performance suggests this step up in trip should suit and the form was boosted when the fourth won at Goodwood last Saturday. Australis only found one too good in the Northumberland Plate last time and he has an obvious chance today, although the fact that he is still a maiden on turf is a slight concern. Others to note are Sleeping Lion, Holy Kingdom and Red Force One.

ATR VERDICT: Look Closely was an impressive winner over C&D last month and the son of Sea The Stars merits plenty of respect today, although an 8lb rise in the ratings will make his life tougher. CARADOC has a very good record on good to firm ground (three wins and two places from six starts) and the going may not have been fast enough for him in either of his previous starts this year. Ed Walker's gelding won a valuable handicap at Newbury last September and he arrives here just 4lb higher in the ratings. Omnivega has improved significantly on the all-weather this year and he could make the frame if transferring that progression to the turf.

ATR VERDICT: Blue De Vega (first) got the better of Han Solo Berger (second) by a nose when they met at Newmarket last month and the pair command a fair amount of respect having been in decent form of late.
