ATR VERDICT: Godolphin have a strong hand here and it could be their LOOKTOTHERAINBOW who takes this for the in-form Charlie Appleby team. The handler is operating at 35 percent with his two-year-olds this term and the Dubawi filly, who is a half-sister to the Group 1-winning Ribchester, can enhance that record. Late Morning also runs in the royal blue and requires a market check, while jockey bookings suggest Joy Choi is the best of Richard Hannon's two. Arion Fox cost 300,000 guineas and is a daughter of Kingman, while Wakening is also of note with John Gosden saddling the Dark Angel filly on behalf of the Queen.

ATR VERDICT: FLY MISS HELEN created a very big impression when making a winning debut at Newbury last month, where she accounted for a useful rival with previous race experience. The daughter of La Havre will have to take a step forward to be successful again today but she looks capable of finding the required improvement. Dubai Fountain and Setarhe finished second and third respectively behind Fev Rover in the Star Stakes at Sandown and they should be in the mix once again today. Daniloova confirmed the promise she displayed on her debut by winning over C&D a week ago, while Spirit Of Bermuda clearly has plenty of ability having made a winning start at Goodwood.

ATR VERDICT: Al Rufaa sets the standard having won twice last month but a 12lb rise for winning over C&D last time has to be a slight concern. With that in mind, a chance can be taken with ROYAL MARINE, who has lost his way since winning a Group 1 as a two-year-old. That said, some promise can be taken from his performances at Meydan earlier in the year. He was not beaten far by Suedois in a very competitive handicap on his first start in the UAE, while he appeared to find 1m1f too far last time. The shortlist is completed by Bear Force One and Fox Champion.
