ATR VERDICT: Throne Hall displayed potential when third on debut at Haydock 12 months ago and the half-brother to Appeared should appreciate this step up in distance. The absence is a slight worry though, and perhaps a more solid option might be to side with Tim Easterby's WAR DEFENDER. The three-year-old is obviously more exposed, but he has shaped well in defeat at Newcastle and Redcar the last twice, and would be tough to stop if running to his rating of 78. William Haggas' Reemannie may prove best of the remainder.
