ATR VERDICT: The Cincinnati Kid cost 70,000gns as a yearling and is a half-brother to seven winners so any market support for Richard Hannon's colt would be interesting, while Sycamore missed the start on debut here last month but made late gains and should be wiser for that experience. That being said, plenty of improvement is also expected from the once-raced TAAMEEN. Third on debut at Haydock behind the 85-rated Lawahed, he was green there but the outing should have done him good.
