ATR VERDICT: Squelch arrives looking to complete a four-timer and demands respect, as does Sir Michael Stoute's progressive filly Almareekh. A big run from Chamade in the previous race would boost the claims of Ghaziyah, who was a pleasing fourth behind her on her comeback, but KEPALA edges the vote. Impressive in victory at Newmarket two starts ago, she took another step forward when chasing home the progressive Dubious Affair (second in Listed company earlier this month) at Newbury last time and should remain competitive despite a further 2lb rise in the ratings.
