ATR VERDICT: There didn't seem to be much luck about MR CARPENTER's 100-1 success at York on stable debut for Tim Easterby last month and the four-year-old could follow up off just 2lb higher. Formerly with David Lanigan, he seemed to love a first try at this trip there and could take some stopping if the forecast rain arrives. Mankayan was second at Ascot when last seen and that winner has since followed up, while the unexposed Prince Imperial is also worth noting with Hollie Doyle doing the steering.
