

She only found the hugely progressive Art Power too strong on debut at Newcastle so a mark of 72 appears workable. Jordan Electrics went up 4lb for a recent success at Ayr and he warrants respect along with Redcar winner Lincoln Gamble.

ATR VERDICT: OAKENSHIELD probably found soft ground too much to handle in a strong Newmarket handicap last month and the return to a sounder surface, combined with the application of cheekpieces, might see Kevin Ryan's gelding return to what he showed when scoring on his first start as a three-year-old at Newcastle. ATR VERDICT: SHADES OF BLUE finished second in this contest 12 months ago and was more competitive as he dropped into a Group 3 when fourth at York last month. The change of headgear, from blinkers to a first-time visor, has the potential to eke out more from Clive Cox's filly.
