ATR VERDICT: Full Authority showed potential for David O'Meara last year when winning on debut at Chester, but he was disappointing when beaten in the National Stakes afterwards, and hasn't been witnessed on the track since. He is with Sir Michael Stoute now, and the market could be a good guide towards expectations. Starman was impressive when scoring at the first time of asking at Lingfield last month, but KING'S LYNN has stronger form. He beat Repartee and Toro Strike here (both rated 101 now) in a valuable sales race in September, and could take some stopping despite an absence of 338 days.
