ATR VERDICT: THIBAAN has shaped nicely in his career so far, including when second to the Royal Ascot winner and Oaks third Frankly Darling at Newcastle in June, and Sir Michael Stoute's War Front colt could be the answer to this competitive event on his handicap bow. A line can be put through Carlos Felix's recent Goodwood effort and he could be a factor if in the same form as when impressing at Ascot on his penultimate run. Nova Roma had excuses when letting down favourite backers at Newbury and is likely to be suited by the return to a sounder surface, with Ayr winner New Chapter and St Just others to note.
