**ATR VERDICT:** Bazaari shaped encouragingly when runner-up on his debut over 7f at Lingfield but a couple of those in behind that day have let the form down since, while Top Brass and Impulsive One both ran well enough first time out to suggest that they could be competitive. However, the experienced runners don't set a daunting standard so it could be a couple of newcomers that fight out the finish. Megallan is certainly bred to have plenty of ability, with his 1m2f Listed-winning dam a half-sister to the top-class Golden Horn, and he warrants respect, but LOCAL LAW gets the vote for a stable that do particularly well in this type of event. He is a half-brother to multiple winners, including dual Group 2 scorer Loxley, and is likely to know his job on debut.
