ATR VERDICT: The first of eight races for two-year-olds. The 82-rated URBAN STEP can put his best foot forward. There was plenty to like about his debut third (on good ground) over five furlongs at this track behind subsequent Group 3 Molecomb winner Steel Bull. He hasn't really built upon that in finishing fifth at this track and sixth in Cork, however, both of those races were on rain-softened ground. A return to this better ground should be in his favour. First-time blinkers go on. Zoffany's Delight didn't cut much ice at the business end of the valuable Ballyhane consolation race here, but won his penultimate start on better ground at Sligo and is dangerous. Dacesa finished out the back of that Ballyhane race, but has definite claims on her previous form.

ATR VERDICT: ELIZABETHAN was caught in the closing stages of a fillies' maiden over an extended six furlongs on soft ground at Limerick, and can get off the mark on this drying ground. The War Front filly is a full sister to the top-class Roly Poly and U S Navy Flag. They both showed their best form on decent ground. Russian River was a ready winner of a barrier trial in Dundalk last week in a good time and could be anything. She looks threatening. Perfect Match showed improvement to come in second in a decent fillies' maiden at Down Royal. The winner of that race wasn't winning out of turn as she had been Listed placed. The Blue Garter made her debut in that race and finished very well for third, so merits respect. Alarm Call is related to several winners and is worth a market check.

ATR VERDICT: The form of the race that HYPE finished eighth in on debut over course and distance in June is sensational, so he is given the nod. He was checked over a furlong out when challenging which did him no favours. An absolute stack of winners have come out of that race including the winner who has since won a Group One, and the fifth home who has been successful in Listed and Group Two company. The horse a place behind Hype has landed a Group 2. The 85-rated Fight Zone can put his experience to good use. He must have been showing up well at home as he was well backed to deliver on debut at the Curragh before finishing fifth in what has proven to be a decent maiden. His last start saw him collared in the final furlong of a seven-furlong race on soft to heavy ground at Gowran Park. He's another War Front horse who ought to appreciate this better ground. Aidan O'Brien takes the wraps off No Nay Never colt Preamble who has to be given a market check. He's a full brother to a horse who won a couple of races albeit in claiming company. Yulong De Legend and Gemini Man are other newcomers to note.

ATR VERDICT: The 78-rated GISELLES THUNDER sets the standard and this appears to be a good opportunity for her. She has put in three solid shifts on rain-softened ground to be second in Navan and fourth in both Tipperary and Navan. Her runner-up berth on debut at Navan reads well as she had subsequent Group 2 winner Miss Amulet behind her in fourth. This drying ground could see her make the breakthrough. Mr Fayeze attracted plenty of support before finishing second on testing ground at Bellewstown. It is worth noting that although he was eighth on debut here, the horse in ninth has since been good enough to win a Navan nursery off 74. Shane Foley looks a good booking for the colt. Basharat showed more when fourth at Bellewstown and can get in the mix.

ATR VERDICT: WHITE PEPPER could be worth a bet to turn around Down Royal form with Verbal Fencing. The latter was very game off the front when holding on by a nose in the north. White Pepper was three-parts of a length further back in third, after running on well in the final furlong to be nearest at the finish. She enjoys a significant pull in the weights with Verbal Fencing who is likely to attempt to tough it out again from the front. Noel Meade's Tosto makes her nursery debut after three unplaced efforts in maiden company. Those runs weren't devoid of ability, though, so she could get closer off an opening mark of 65. Her stablemate Wonder Spirit is another potential improver. Equilove has the ability to make her presence felt.









ATR VERDICT: The well-related FRIENDLY can strike. She was beaten into second at Leopardstown last month by a horse that connections view as a Group-race filly. You would think that Friendly ought to be up to winning a fillies' maiden on the back of that. Giuliana also filled the runner-up spot in Punchestown and can serve it up to Friendly. The form of that run has been boosted as the fourth home (a stablemate of Friendly's) won a Listed race at Leopardstown on Irish Champions Weekend. Even the form of Giuliana's eighth on debut at Navan looks good as that race has thrown up a plethora of quality winners. Sense Of Style is the other big player with a pair of second places in August. She was a couple of places in front of Giuliana on debut at Navan, so is entitled to be right in contention.

ATR VERDICT: A race where the market must be monitored. Sea The Stars colt SOUTHERN LIGHTS could shine on debut. Joseph O'Brien's charge won a barrier trial in Dundalk last week as the first two pulled clear of the remainder. That experience should stand him in good stead, and it is notable that he holds a Group 2 entry this month. Aidan O'Brien's Khartoum has the same Group 2 entry, and is regally bred being by Grade One winner Pioneerof The Nile out of Group 2 winner Up. He sold for \$1,000,000 at the Keeneland 2019 September Yearling Sale, and has to rate a major player in this race. Denis Hogan's Whyzzat is related to plenty of winners, and could outrun his odds.

ATR VERDICT: Alex D should take plenty of beating with a mark of 88. A third place on debut behind subsequent Group One winner Lucky Vega over six furlongs at this track in June reads very well. He wasn't at his best when fourth at the Curragh, but bounced back to form when just denied by a nose in Limerick. However, EMPORIO might be a shade of value against him. This Zoffany colt must be well regarded as he has a Group 2 Beresford Stakes entry at the Curragh this month. In addition, he avails of Gavin Ryan's 3lb claim. Man Of Peace, Kailash and Simplyirresistible represent stables more than capable of saddling one to win on debut. Ben Asker was runner-up in a Dundalk barrier trial and Castle Stables was third in one, so they cannot be ruled out.
