ATR VERDICT: It might pay to side with HIGHWAYGREY, a three-time C&D winner who had been in cracking form before a slightly disappointing effort on soft ground at Haydock latest. Back on a faster surface, at a track he clearly loves, don't be surprised if he bounces right back to form. Gift Of Kings justified favouritism at Newcastle last time and warrants respect switching back to turf off only 3lb higher mark, while the dropped-in-class Archie Perkins is no forlorn hope from the opposite end of the weights.
