ATR VERDICT: ALLAGAR is by far the most experienced in the line-up but her form has improved along with that of the Bolger yard in general over the past month. She was third to Charterhouse in a decent Curragh maiden before being drawn on the wrong side in the valuable Ballyhane Stakes at Naas. The daughter of Vocalised then didn't enjoy the clearest of passages when only beaten just over two lengths in the Group 3 Flame Of Tara Stakes and again was far from disgraced in Stakes company at Leopardstown last Saturday. Talacre, a half-sister to stablestar Siskin, has shown promise on all three starts including when just denied by Nicest at Leopardstown. La Joconde is also bred in the purple being a Frankel half-sister to this year's Irish Derby winner Santiago, and it would be no surprise to see her progress from a nice debut fifth at Cork.

ATR VERDICT: TRUSTED ALLY appears the one to beat. The Michael O'Callaghan-trained colt finished well when narrowly beaten in third behind Giorgio Vasari (now rated 98) on debut over an extended six furlongs at Limerick. He was hampered next time at Galway before again keeping on behind Mac Swiney in the Group 2 Futurity Stakes at the Curragh. He looks well capable of a maiden win at least with an official rating of 95 and the step up to a mile should suit. It would be no surprise if Sir William Bruce stepped up from his debut fourth at Leopardstown, while the booking of Colin Keane on newcomer Whipsaw catches the eye.

ATR VERDICT: Ado McGuinness enjoyed a great Galway Festival with SALTONSTALL providing one of the highlights by landing the Colm Quinn BMW Mile Premier Handicap for the second successive year. The Pivotal gelding didn't enjoy the clearest of runs last time in the Cambridgeshire and Gavin Ryan's 3lb claim is a real bonus. Lord Rapscallion has really progressed this year winning twice under apprentice Nikita Kane, who was also on board when coming from off the pace to finish second in the valuable Sovereign Path Premier Handicap at Leopardstown last Saturday. Eldama has the most scope for improvement having won a Leopardstown maiden on debut and really put it up to the progressive Fame And Acclaim on her only subsequent outing at Punchestown.

ATR VERDICT: BLANKIEDOODIE won three times last year including at this venue and in general appears best on good ground. The gelded son of Halling has been in good form of late with three placed efforts over the past five weeks including when beaten just over a length behind Jungle Jungle also at Gowran. He beat all bar Overheer at Tipperary on Tuesday and the drop back to a mile should suit. The wide draw is the obvious negative. Macaban City gave encouragement when third to Ivy Avenue over course and distance last time, while Adapt To Dan is another in decent form. Capablanca only weakened inside the final furlong when reappearing after a 10-month absence at Limerick last week, and it will be interesting to see how he fares running back guickly over this shorter trip.

ATR VERDICT: EVERYHOURONTHEHOUR was prominent throughout when winning twice over this trip at Dundalk last winter, and perhaps he can make use of a low draw with Colin Keane an eyecatching booking. The Dragon Pulse gelding has dropped down the ratings since but showed a bit more sparkle when fitted with a tongue-tie for the first time at the Curragh last month. By contrast Eye Of The Dragon didn't show much on the Polytrack at Dundalk but was noted staying on behind Pulsating at Navan last week. Pulsating would obviously be a threat to all if getting a run from second reserve but she was also engaged at Dundalk on Friday, while Camilla Sina may appreciate the step back to a mile.

ATR VERDICT: It might be as simple as rowing in behind the top-rated ENNISTYMON here.
