ATR VERDICT: Point-to-point and bumper GERALDO can make a winning hurdles debut. He has shown a good level of ability thus far and while beaten by an unfancied stablemate at Kilbeggan on bumper debut, did comfortably win his bumper at Cork subsequently and comes here open to more progression as he goes jumping. Risk Factor is himself a capable type and was Grade 2 placed in a Leopardstown bumper last February. He was held in second when unseating his rider at the last at Galway in July and while the winner was well beaten subsequently, Risk Factor is open to some more progression over hurdles and should give the selection a race. Charcor was a smart flat performer and while well held by Dewcup at Punchestown recently, is also open to improvement on his second hurdles start and is another with solid claims. Annexation was a useful flat performer and is a notable hurdle newcomer. He has yet to race beyond a mile and half a furlong but is just a 4yo who has shown form on soft ground, which suggests he can stay longer trips on a sounder surface. Paul Townend is a notable booking for another hurdle newcomer Tirmizi who has good middle-distance flat form to his name but is a late-comer to jumping aged seven. Lignou is probably best watched on his first start for almost a year.

ATR VERDICT: THE MOUSE DOCTOR has been in excellent form and can gain a sixth win. He has raced just ten times over hurdles and remains a fraction unexposed in this sphere, and comes here having run another good race when third in a Grade B race at Killarney last month. Shumaker is a proven handicapper who was thoroughly progressive in winning three handicap hurdles on soft ground last October. He has since shown good form on a sound surface, winning twice on the flat, and while well enough held on his latest handicap hurdle run at Galway, that was in a higher rated handicap and he should go well. Mandarin Monarch has already won eight times and while he comes here clearly fit and well, might proven vulnerable to a few better handicapped types. Chosen Hour is without a recent run but is rated 7lbs higher over fences following his Punchestown beginners chase win last January. He would ideally prefer a longer trip but has at least won at this trip in the past. Silver Star has been running well in defeat in similar handicaps recently and has place claims. Arthur Fonzarelli showed improved form to win at Killarney last month and while in truth he stole the race at the start, he is nonetheless interesting in his first handicap from 114. Ashton Court loves finishing second but faces a tougher task today than his recent good efforts in defeat. Scalor beat a subsequent winner at Killarney in July but faces a tougher task than when third at Clonmel latest.

ATR VERDICT: WHITANGO has shown good consistency recently and can get off the mark here. A lightly raced 8yo, he was absent for three years before reappearing this year but has shown ability in similar handicaps and comes here proven a proven stayer on a sound surface who looks likely to win from his mark with his rider again claiming 7lbs. Miraculum is a free going type who failed to justify strong support on the flat on her most recent outing but has claims on her best previous form while Don't Let Go is a dual winner who is rated 8lbs lower over hurdles than fences but was beaten 23L on her latest start. Long March was gambled on handicap debut in a similar race over 2m4f at Wexford latest and whil he did make a bad mistake in-running, he was ultimately disappointing and needs to show more here. Point-to-point winner The Great White was well held on his three maiden hurdle outings but could go well on handicap debut from 97 as he drops in grade.

ATR VERDICT: HEWICK caused a surprise to win at Kilbeggan recently and could follow up here. His form was just ordinary prior to his Kilbeggan win but that win was gained as he was upped to a staying trip for the first time since his point-to-point days. He has been raised 8lbs for the win and meets the runner-up then Trouble And Strife 6lbs worse off but could continue to progress a little more. The step up in trip also seemed to benefit Trouble And Strife at Kilbeggan (being a proven flat stayer) and she should run a solid race today. I Will Walk was sixth in that Kilbeggan race but had at least run two solid races in similar handicaps and has some place claims.

ATR VERDICT: PREMIUM PACKAGE has shown a good level of ability thus far and can follow up last month's Down Royal win. He showed good promise on debut and while he subsequently disappointed at Tramore in July, he was a good winner of his maiden hurdle with the form receiving a boost with the third-placed horse winning next time. He looks likely to be well suited by the step up to 2m6f and gets 9lbs from top weight Road To Dubai. Road To Dubai is a different type in that he comes from a flat background but has also shown good hurdles form. He will benefit from his recent reappearance run at Naas but today's trip could stretch him stamina-wise and he might struggle to give weight to the selection. Samurai Cracker comes from the hunter chase scene and was capable at that grade. He was an interesting recruit to hurdles when finishing second at Down Royal last month and while well beaten by the winner, did notably finish ahead of Dinons and could well play a part today from a low enough weight. Little Lady Lu's rider claims a very helpful 5lbs and has a very light weight but should still struggle to win.

ATR VERDICT: Though the going was still described as good, the rain probably arrived at the wrong time for CRIMSON CHIEF at Tramore in August. He's since won a Downpatrick handicap hurdle and he can show that Tramore festival handicap chase performance to be all wrong. The Arcadio gelding definitely enjoys the ground 'on top,' and he's very likely to have his conditions here. There's no reason to think that he'll do anything other than enjoy the big track at Navan, and two and a half miles should be a good trip for the former point-to-point scorer. Benefit Run and Whatsinthecorner are others for the shortlist.

ATR VERDICT: The silks that Patrick Mullins dons aboard GLADIATORIAL, were carried to success by a mare called Simone at Punchestown in May 2017. Cheltenham and Galway festival winning rider Steven Clements won on her, and she was notable as a half-sister to Simonsig. Shane Nolan had care of Simone as well, before she went on to race in the UK. These connections certainly know the time of day and it could be that they've been waiting for better ground for Gladiatorial. He made a reasonable debut but was disappointing on a soft surface after that. The likes of Hes A Hardy Bloke and Chemical Energy also take the eye.
