


ATR VERDICT: MANAABIT has won three of her last four and the three-year-old daughter of Kodiak, who is unbeaten since joining the handicap ranks, could continue her progression here off a 4lb higher mark. Mostly is now tried in a tongue-tie having raced too keenly at Yarmouth last month, while Lady Lynetta was a winner at Haydock on her penultimate start and lost little in defeat when contesting a muddling affair at Goodwood last time.

ATR VERDICT: ARABIC CHARM has been knocking on the door since joining the handicap ranks, including when third off this rating at Sandown last time, and she could be let in today. The return to faster ground should suit and Marco Ghiani removes a handy 5lb. Blue Skyline relished the soft ground when getting off the mark over 7f on the July course last month, but does have a few questions to answer on this quicker surface. Nonetheless, Ryan Moore keeps the faith and he has to be respected in first-time blinkers. There was plenty to like about Lily Like's fourth at Haydock, while One Small Step could have plenty more to come in this sphere and this looks her ideal distance.

ATR VERDICT: Under normal circumstances when coming in here on the back of just two runs on the level, the thought process might have been that a lack of experience would catch OCEAN WIND out in a tough race. However, he beat a good yardstick impressively at Lingfield last month and his NH form in Listed bumpers at Cheltenham and Newbury will stand the son of Teofilo in good stead. Platitude has performed well in defeat this year and isn't without a chance, while the Mark Johnston pair Themaxwecan and Rochester House should also be thereabouts at the business end.

ATR VERDICT: A select but competitive handicap in which ANGEL FAIRY gets the nod. She is still learning and might have won at Sandown last time if she wasn't so slowly into stride. She flashed her tail leaving the stalls that day, showing signs of greenness, but ran on at the finish over 1m2f so might appreciate going up in distance off just 1lb higher. Folk Dance and Kepala are progressive and must have good chances on what they have shown this year, while Chicago Doll should have her say despite giving a good bit of weight to the aforementioned three-year-olds.

ATR VERDICT: This stiff 6f trip should be right up BREANSKI's street and his latest Doncaster effort over the distance confirms he's in good form. You would imagine the stable companion Flavius Titus will go forward, with perhaps Dulas who made most to win at Newcastle two starts ago, to ensure there is a good pace for the experienced six-year-old to aim at and, a multiple winner over 7f and 1m, Jamie Spencer could be the perfect jockey booking as he attempts to finish fast and late. My Style looks the main danger on a hat-trick.

ATR VERDICT: GERANIUM stayed on well to finish third in a tougher contest at Sandown last time out and should be ideally suited by this drying ground under leading amateur Serena Brotherton. The five-year-old is the most solid option in this competitive contest and appeals marginally more than Angel's Whisper, who returns to the Flat chasing a hat-trick after finishing second over hurdles at Southwell four weeks ago. Luna Magic was a little disappointing at Goodwood when last seen but didn't look suited by the track.
