**ATR VERDICT:** ARABIC CHARM has been knocking on the door since joining the handicap ranks, including when third off this rating at Sandown last time, and she could be let in today. The return to faster ground should suit and Marco Ghiani removes a handy 5lb. Blue Skyline relished the soft ground when getting off the mark over 7f on the July course last month, but does have a few questions to answer on this quicker surface. Nonetheless, Ryan Moore keeps the faith and he has to be respected in first-time blinkers. There was plenty to like about Lily Like's fourth at Haydock, while One Small Step could have plenty more to come in this sphere and this looks her ideal distance.

**ATR VERDICT:** GERANIUM stayed on well to finish third in a tougher contest at Sandown last time out and should be ideally suited by this drying ground under leading amateur Serena Brotherton. The five-year-old is the most solid option in this competitive contest and appeals marginally more than Angel's Whisper, who returns to the Flat chasing a hat-trick after finishing second over hurdles at Southwell four weeks ago.
