ATR VERDICT: COLLINSBAY remains a maiden after four starts for Richard Hannon, but he shaped well when fifth in a competitive sales race at Doncaster 10 days ago and should appreciate this step back up to 7f with Ryan Moore doing the steering. Qaasid found things happening too quickly on debut at Kempton last time but is fancied to be wiser for that experience, while similar comments apply to Decisive Edge, who showed good early pace on Polytrack just over a fortnight ago.

ATR VERDICT: HARRY'S BAR is 2-4 at this venue for James Fanshawe, including here last month, and could have more to offer given his unexposed profile over this distance. The five-year-old beat a classy field on that occasion and could defy a 6lb rise now under Tom Marquand. Animal Instinct is a two-time C&D winner and returned to action impressively when successful here in June, while Kimifive seldom runs a bad race at this level and could also make his presence felt.

ATR VERDICT: Fleur Irlandaise caused a 100-1 surprise when successful at Kempton over hurdles last November but hasn't been in the same form since and was outpaced at Lingfield on the level 18 days ago. Competition didn't seem suited by soft ground at Chepstow last month and could bounce back, although it will take a good effort to account for SUNSHINEANDBUBBLES. Successful over C&D earlier this month, the seven-year-old was never troubled there and could defy a 6lb rise for David Evans.

ATR VERDICT: Indian Affair is a model of consistency and picked up the silver medal off this mark on his last start over course and distance in March. Any money for him on his return from 198 days off the track would be worth heeding, though narrow preference is for DELAGATE THE LADY, who is rated only 1lb higher than when touched off by a neck on turf at Yarmouth in July. Vincenzo Coccotti is another worthy of shortlist inclusion.
