ATR VERDICT: A useful mares' maiden and ERINS BENEFIT could win on jumps debut. She was beaten in her initial two bumpers but ran good races in defeat before routing her rivals to win at Bellewstown in August. She won in the style of a capable mare then and while the ground was easy and the opposition soft, she powered home, is already well proven on a sound surface and appears the type to do well over jumps stepping up in trip. The obvious danger is another smart prospect Beret Rouge, who herself created a very favourable impression when winning at Roscommon in June. The form of that bumper is nothing special but she did win very easily and it will be very interesting to see her also going up in trip against ERINS BENEFIT today. Walking Fame was a controversial winner of a Downpatrick bumper latest and while experienced over hurdles, needs to improve to win today. Felicidad makes her debut for a new trainer having been with Nick Williams in Britain and while progression is possibly, she might struggle to win. Eightytwo Team carries the same colours as the delightfully misspelled winner Nintytwo Team of the 00's although she is best watched on debut today.

ATR VERDICT: SONG OF EARTH has a very good opportunity to win on hurdles debut. He disappointed on debut at Limerick over Christmas but turned around that form when winning at Wexford in March, with the third-placed horse subsequently winning a maiden hurdle. He has been absent since and while fast ground could be a concern, connections will surely have had this race in mind for some weeks and he is sure to be well schooled. E43,000 Landrover Sale purchase Defan squeezes in at these race conditions and is a notable newcomer from a very capable yard. He is out of a point-to-point winner who is from the family of useful staying jumpers and could go well today. Dedanann is winless from 13 starts but has plenty experience over hurdles and while vulnerable to more able types, should still at least reach the placings, under a 7lbs claimer.

ATR VERDICT: MR MOONDANCE might be able to complete the hat-trick. He is a well raced type who despite having had 58 career runs, managed to win his last two handicap hurdles at Sligo in August and while raised 8lbs for his latest success, should still prove competitive in this winneable handicap, with trip and ground in his favour. Caridadi is another 9yo and while he was well beaten on his latest flat start, had previously been in good form in handicap hurdles and can go well today. Locally trained All The Angels could also go well as he remains less exposed. He ran a nice race at Tramore recently and notably, both his wins last year came on good ground and over this trip with today's rider able to claim 2lbs.

ATR VERDICT: Connections of CERBERUS was brought in before the stewards following his run on the flat at Navan recently and could now successfully revert to hurdling. He was a smart juvenile hurdler last term and having twice placed at Grade 1 level, finished the curtailed season with a good sixth placing in the Triumph Hurdle at Cheltenham. He has plenty weight to give away today but his recent away-day at Navan will have brought him on plenty and he can prove competitive in his first handicap hurdle. Fujimoto Flyer was herself a smart performer last term and while her lack of a recent outing isn't ideal, she nonetheless won a Listed Hurdle at Autueil last Sept and was second at Grade 2 level at Kempton in February. Anna Bunina and Yafordadoe are both chasing hat-tricks and while they have obvious claims, each has risen through the ratings and as they step up in class. Saint D'Oroux was third in the Fred Winter at Cheltenham last March and while thus is proven in this grade, possibly needs to show more than on his two runs in July. Red Gerry has a much tougher task than when winning his maiden hurdle earlier this month while Bear Claws similarly faces a sterner test than when beating today's lightly rated rival Marmolata at Tramore.

ATR VERDICT: SMITHSCORNER has been in excellent form over fences recently and can successfully revert to hurdles here. He has run just twice over hurdles since December 2018 but in that time has progressed very well through the chase ranks and comes here rated 29lbs lower over hurdles than his current chase mark, with trip and ground in his favour today. Kilkeaskins First was ahead of Rightplacerighttime at Bellewstown latest and both have place claims again while Thousand Tears and Ballinaboola Steel are both capable in this grade and comes here in good form, albeit possibly not ahead of the handicapper. Fairyhill Run steps up from a recent maiden hurdle win and is somewhat interesting on handicap debut while The Wonky Tonk was a good ground winner in July but has been well held since. Luis Van Zandt stays very well but disappointed at Punchestown recently.

ATR VERDICT: PAKENS ROCK might get off the mark on his second attempt over fences. A capable hurdler, he ran well on chase debut at Galway a fortnight ago and while beaten 1.75L by more experienced Scheu Time then, he should improve for the run and meets that rival 7lbs better off. Scheu Time is himself a capable type and while rated 120 over fences, that is less than PAKENS ROCK's 135 rating over hurdles. Play The Game is a notable chase newcomer as he was a smart performer both on the flat and over hurdles. He is bred for the flat but is nonetheless well experienced over hurdles and is a previous course and distance winner over hurdles. Le Musigny won a big-field maiden hurdle at Punchestown last January and while beaten 16L in a Listed race subsequently, is capable of more improvement over fences but lacks a recent outing. Soldier At War was fairly useful over hurdles but is long absent.

ATR VERDICT: THE ABBEY can build upon his only other crack at fences when runner-up in a beginners' chase at Downpatrick in August. He attempted to make all, on good ground, and was caught inside the final furlong as he finished second. He was well clear of the third, though, and that horse gave the form a boost by winning a beginners' chase in Tramore by 14 lengths. Ozzie's Way has been placed in his last two chases and is well capable of a bold show on this better ground. Something Sweet is entitled to get in the mix off bottom weight. Aprils Joy hasn't had much fortune in her two beginners' chases - she had a slipped saddle when third in Kilbeggan and was brought down in Sligo. Paul Townend is an eye-catching booking and her chance is respected. She is a former point-to-point winner.
