ATR VERDICT: OUTBACK BOY stepped forward from his racecourse debut at Ascot when running on to finish third at Haydock earlier in the month and the step up in distance promises to unlock further progression from Mark Johnston's colt. Juan De Montalban is likely to have benefited from his first start when fourth at Haydock last month, while a set of cheekpieces are likely to aid the cause of Act Of Wisdom, a brother of Breeders Cup Juvenile Turf hero Line Of Duty.

ATR VERDICT: Lihou arrives following two cracking efforts at Chester, win and placed, and should make his presence felt, while Al Dawodiya won gamely at Lingfield recently and is likely to show up well again. However, from further down the weights, narrow preference is for THE LAMPLIGHTER. He built on a couple of solid placed efforts, including in class 2 company over course and distance, when scoring comfortably at Kempton and looks sure to play a leading role returning to turf off just a 1lb higher mark.

Mostawaa was touched off over 1m at Haydock last time and should remain competitive off 2lb higher, while Zhui Feng looks a danger to all now eased in grade. ATR VERDICT: BENNY AND THE JETS is probably more effective on the all-weather, but he is 7lb lower on turf and has recorded a couple of reasonable efforts in defeat on this surface already in recent months. The four-year-old has the most scope for improvement in this field, and appeals slightly more than Union Rose, who is on a hat-trick for Ron Harris under a 4lb penalty. Wiley Post was in good form at Kempton over the winter and also merits respect.
