Fourth at Wolverhampton behind a winner who has since followed up under a penalty, that form looks strong and Tom Marquand is a positive jockey booking.

ATR VERDICT: \$800,000 yearling SECRET PROTECTOR wasn't beaten far on debut in an aboveaverage C&D contest earlier this month and could get off the mark here for Godolphin. The War Front colt stayed on strongly there and should be much wiser for the experience. Marrakech Moon is related to plenty of winners and his handler often introduces nice types on synthetic surfaces at this time of year, while fellow newcomer Mardoof has the right sort of pedigree for Polytrack and is worthy of a market check.

ATR VERDICT: UNDERWATER ATTACK sets a fair form standard after finding only the Convivial runner-up too hot to handle on debut at Leicester earlier this month and might go one better here. A half-brother to Group 1 winner Royal Marine, the Dawn Approach colt can take this before a potentially profitable winter in Dubai for Saeed bin Suroor. Thunder Sun failed to beat anything home on debut 62 days ago but is bred to do much better given time, while Sir Edward Elgar cost 82,000gns as a yearling and appeals most of the debutants on paper.
