ATR VERDICT: RED MISSILE cost 38,000gns at the Tattersalls Horses-in-Training sale last month following his first success for William Haggas on the level at Lingfield. The gelding boasts a decent level of ability and is of considerable interest now going over timber for Lucinda Russell. Billy The Squid can enter the reckoning despite coming here on the back of unseating his rider at Southwell, while Ten Thousand Stars is capable of improvement having finished third on his hurdling debut at Sedgefield.

ATR VERDICT: Nigel Twiston-Davies tends to send one of his better novice chase prospects to this event, having won it on numerous occasions this century, and REDFORD ROAD attempts to continue the Naunton handler's fine record. A more than useful novice hurdler, having won a Grade 2 over 3m at Cheltenham in December, he contested the Albert Bartlett when clearly not at his best but the impression left was that he would achieve more once switched to the larger obstacles. Saglawy warmed up with a spin on the level at Haydock earlier in the month and boasts some decent hurdles form in Ireland, while Big Bad Bear progressed well last season until disappointing at Wetherby and appeals most of the remainder.

ATR VERDICT: Check My Pulse converted a couple of podium finishes into a comfortable victory at Uttoxeter last month, but faces a tougher task this time around, having to concede weight all-round. Percy's Word is interesting following almost two years off the track representing Dan Skelton, while Universal Gleam is rated 95 on the Flat and now tries hurdling with Brian Hughes in the saddle. ATR VERDICT: STONER'S CHOICE, who wasn't disgraced in a pair of Listed bumpers last winter, made a pleasing hurdles debut when second over track and trip last month and a cleaner round of jumping could hand Fergal O'Brien's five-year-old a first victory here. ATR VERDICT: TALKTOMENOW wasn't at his best last season for Warren Greatrex, but he looked unsuited by testing ground at Catterick and Ascot during the winter and could relish this return to better ground. Now with new owners after a wind operation, the six-year-old looks to be on a favourable mark of 107 before Jack Tudor's 5lb claim is taken into account. Petite Ganache has finished third here the last twice and is expected to be competitive again, while Mead Vale returned to form when fourth here last month and is unexposed over this sort of distance.
