If the son of Fast Company can improve again today then he should take plenty of stopping. Fayathaan and Conspiracy are others who bring solid form to the table and could make the frame. Bakersboy cost 100,000gns as a yearling and he is a half-brother to the high-class sprinter Kachy, while Lafan is another noteworthy debutant.



ATR VERDICT: DONTASKMEAGAIN looked useful in two victories as a juvenile before disappointing in the Autumn Stakes at Newmarket last October. The son of Karakontie is capable of bouncing back to form on his handicap debut with the step up in distance likely to unlock some improvement. Highwaygrey won over C&D last week and commands respect under a 5lb penalty, while Victory Chime is of interest having run with credit in some competitive handicaps recently.

ATR VERDICT: DARK JEDI has been in very consistent form throughout 2020 and produced a career best when runner-up in the Old Borough Cup over 1m6f at Haydock earlier in the month. Floating Artist is respected as he drops back into handicap company having been dropped 2lb since his latest start in a conditions event at Salisbury. Not So Sleepy enjoyed a decent spell over timber last year, winning a valuable prize at Ascot in December, and cannot be discounted on his return to the level.

ATR VERDICT: ALMINOOR has an attractive, unexposed profile and is taken to land the spoils on his handicap debut. The three-year-old may improve for that comeback run, and for stepping up in distance, so a bold bid looks assured.
