**ATR VERDICT:** Carlos Felix looked unsuited by the track at Goodwood last month but previously looked progressive when beating a talented field at Ascot a fortnight previously. Mr Carpenter is 2-3 for Tim Easterby but both of those successes have come at York, and preference instead is for DOUBLING DICE.
