ATR VERDICT: HAMMERSMITH brings solid hurdles form here and can get off the mark over jumps. His leading flat sire No Nay Never is known as a produced of fast horses and while he yet to have a jumps winner (from four runners), HAMMERSMITH does get this trip and comes here following a useful run at Wexford recently (the fifth-placed horse won a handicap on next outing) and had previously shown useful form on soft ground last season. Annie Pender has shown form on testing ground but has also shown wayward tendencies. She hangs left in her races and while that shouldn't inconvenience badly today, she nonetheless isn't easy and has 6lbs to find with the selection on adjusted ratings. Wojood's only flat win was on the all-weather and while he ran a good race on hurdles debut at Clonmel, would ideally prefer a sound surface and might struggle to win this. Henry De Bromhead declared Kapard to run in a Thurles bumper last March, which is noteworthy, and while she was withdrawn due to a passport irregularity, is now sent straight hurdling and could go well, being out of a winning dam who is a half-sister to Al Fero.

ATR VERDICT: Four-year-old FINEST EVERMORE won a Tipperary maiden hurdle in August in the manner of a mare going places and can beat more experienced rivals and win this. She ran well on debut for Harry Kelly, changed ownership and won easily at Cork in July and then won an ordinary maiden by a wide margin at Tipperary. She takes a big enough step up in grade here but is open to plenty more progression and likes the trip and ground. Lynwood Gold is herself a capable mare and comes here in excellent form from the flat, where she is rated 91. She has already proven herself in soft ground maiden hurdles, winning at Navan in March in a useful race where the fourth, fifth and second-last have all won races since. She should go well but is vulnerable to a high class type. Saint D'Oroux is another capable type and having won his maiden hurdle easily at Gowran in February, then filled third in the Fred Winter at Cheltenham. His reappearance runs haven't been quite up to that standard but his Galway third was a useful race and he can get involved at the business end. Jacksons Gold and Deployed step up from recent maiden hurdle wins but face stiffer tasks while Bold Enough was well held latest and might struggle in this grade.

ATR VERDICT: DRUMACOO might be able to win this on his first start since December. He was well held on his latest start in a Grade B handicap chase last Christmas but had previously shown up very well in useful handicap hurdles at Fairyhouse and Navan. Those races were very similar to today's race and he is likely to have been primed by a local trainer for this with trip and ground very much in his favour. Stablemate Humm Baby is herself a dual course winner who comes here in good form. She is proven in this grade and while she should go very well, would ideally prefer a reasonably sound surface. Hewick showed improved form when upped to staying trips recently but might ideally prefer a sounder surface and also now competes from a career-high mark. Faughernon showed just ordinary form in maiden hurdles but has progressed well in handicaps since and won a big-field and competitive Leopardstown handicap last Christmas. His latest run was in another useful handicap at that same track in March and while his lack of a recent outing is a minor concern, he also steps up to a trip over which he disappointed previously. Born By The Sea is in excellent form and while not ahead of the handicapper, should still run another solid race under his 7lbs claimer. Young Dev is well suited by testing ground and can get involved despite his 206 days absence. So Near So Farhh was a handicap winner latest but steps up in class while Grange Walk steps out of maiden company for the first time.

ATR VERDICT: WOODBROOK BOY has flopped on occasions but comes here a potentially nicely handicapped hurdler. A dual point-to-point winner, he failed to win in five hurdle starts but this year has progressed very well over fences. He was well enough held at Kilbeggan latest and was pulled up at Tramore in August but they were from a 125 rating and he reverts to hurdles today rated just 95 for an in-form yard. Padraic O'Conaire is a previous course and distance winner with recent form but would prefer a sound surface, while Dualla Time and Hussle Up are long absent but have some claims on previous best form. Withallduerespect was well held on handicap debut recently. Exit To The West won her latest point-to-point start but that was back in February and she had previously been well enough beaten in two handicap hurdles.

ATR VERDICT: NORTHERN LOVE is absent for 272 days but can win this from top weight. He showed little in three maiden hurdles but caused a 20/1 upset on handicap debut at Limerick last Christmas and is now a proven performer in this grade, over this trip and on testing ground. His lack of a recent outing certainly isn't ideal but his local trainer targets this meeting. Midlands Millie herself hasn't races since February but she too can run well. She is also well proven in this grade, goes well on testing ground and is, generally, a consistent performer. Westernerona wasn't beaten too far latest but could prefer a sound surface while Cluan Dara has been chasing recently but has won just once in 39 starts and might ideally prefer a longer trip. Knockraha Boss, an 11yo, is proven in this grade and on testing ground and wasn't beaten too far here on Sunday.

ATR VERDICT: VENEZIANO SPRINGS has solid claims here having run a nice race on reappearance at Killarney last month. He is a proven soft ground performer at this distance and while he has won just twice in 24 starts, he ran a good race at Killarney and should go well from the same mart today. Jan Maat has claims under top weight, being a capable type at best. He won a Punchestown Grade 3 contest last October, finished mid-field in the Grand Annual Chase at Cheltenham and while he wasn't beaten too far at Galway latest, he would ideally prefer a sound surface but does at least proven course form (having chased home Wicklow Brave here in 2019). Email Rose is a frustrating type to follow and while he is every inch a chaser, his latest run at Roscommon was disappointing and he needs to show more on handicap chase debut. Winter Escape was behind Jan Maat in the Grand Annual but ran a better race on his second spell for his present trainer at Galway in July and has now dropped 3lbs. Mick The Jiver will find the trip too sharp on his reappearance run.

ATR VERDICT: DEADHEAT can follow up his recent Wexford win. He began his racing life in his native France where he won three hurdles and competed at a high level racing at Autueil and while probably no longer at that level (he did have a 490 days layoff after a November 2018 run), he has returned in good form this year and comes here as a proven soft ground performer who can cope with a recent 7lbs hike for winning a similar race at Wexford latest. Sir Bob won on point-to-point debut and while he has yet to win in 13 racecourse outings, ran a good race from a lower hurdle rating when last seen at Navan in January and is at least very much proven on testing ground. Rudy Catrail has been in excellent form this year and while well held by DEADHEAT at Wexford latest, had previously won a soft ground handicap hurdle by a wide margin at Tipperary in August. Something Sweet wasn't beaten far here on Sunday and could go well on handicap chase debut.

ATR VERDICT: Much of the previous form on display here has been on good ground and WESEEK HIMHERE is tipped in the hope he can cope with an easier surface today. He was almost knocked over on debut at Roscommon in July but later that month won well at Galway and looks the type who can win more races. Stablemate Mars Harper was an unconsidered 16/1 chance when winning on debut at Ballinrobe and while this is a step up on grade, the form of that bumper has been boosted by the third-placed horse winning subsequently with today's rider again claiming 7lbs. Ardla did well to win on debut at Punchestown recently and while open to progression, the third and fourth placed horses from Punchestown (runner-up Knockmoylan re-opposes in a first-time tongue-tie today) have been well beaten since. Similarly Staging Post's bumper form at Sligo has yet to work out while Camp David ran a good race on debut at Galway 58 days ago and could get involved today.
