ATR VERDICT: Kastasa slammed 2018 winner Cypress Creek in this event 12 months ago but after returning with a Gowran triumph, she then had to settle for third in the Stanerra Stakes, with Traisha just ahead of her. In any case, giving 7lb to DAWN PATROL may prove beyond both fillies because the Aidan O'Brien-trained son of Galileo made the frame in the Irish Derby in the summer. He also ran well in another Classic when sixth in the Doncaster Leger and, as long as he stays, could be a class above these.
