






ATR VERDICT: It is hard to oppose MOHAWK KING, who has not been disgraced in a pair of Group 2 contests since making a winning debut in July. With his sights lowered today the son of Siyouni should be very hard to beat. Hemmsa may struggle against the selection but she has shown promise in both of her previous outings and should be in the mix for the minor honours. Glinbury cost 48,000gns last year and he merits a market inspection on his racecourse debut.
