


ATR VERDICT: CHUVELO looked an exciting prospect when winning a bumper here by 23 lengths in December and it is interesting that Donald McCain returns to a venue he knows well for the five-year-old's hurdling debut having caught the eye throughout his season in the bumper ranks. ATR VERDICT: Jonjo O'Neill won this 12 months ago and has a great chance once again with recent Perth scorer Write It Down, who could prove just as effective stepping up in trip off a 7lb higher mark. However, preference is for PACKETTOTHERAFTERS, who has a great record here and is only 2lb higher than when just failing to run down the winner at Southwell last month. Marble Moon is 4lb lower than his track-and-trip victory here last summer and can't be ignored, while Henry's Joy has been threatening the scoresheet of late and his conditional jockey removes a handy 7lb.


