














ATR VERDICT: HIDDEN CARGO has been a model of consistency of late and the application of a tongue-tie and the return of James Bowen to the saddle could be all that is required to see the eight-year-old land a deserved success here. Doctor Haze went close at Stratford on his reappearance and is interesting stepping up in trip off a 11lb higher mark. Silent Encore hit the crossbar over track and trip off this rating in March and is another to take seriously.

ATR VERDICT: With no form to go on at all the market will be a key guide but the marginal preference is for STITCHED, who is a rare bumper runner for Hugo Palmer. The son of Siyouni is a half-brother to Titi Makfi, who was a Listed winner and Group 2-placed on the Flat over 1m4f, and the booking of Harry Cobden suggests that he has been showing some promise at home. Green Planet is another with an attractive profile, while Arthur's Seat and Little Miss Madam also make the shortlist.
