ATR VERDICT: COLFER KAY is going the right way. She was nearest at the finish in fifth on debut in a good fillies' maiden at Down Royal and improved upon that to finish half a length second in Limerick. The horse that beat her there has since been placed in a Group 3. Colfer Kay handles soft ground and plenty of rain is forecast. Preamble's debut third at Naas was laden with potential. He suffered a less than clear route but, once switched, he kept on to be beaten a length and a quarter. Semanya was another placed on debut, this time over course and distance. I Am Magnetic sets the standard with a mark of 82. He handles cut in the ground and his experience is an advantage against so many newcomers. It is worth noting, though, that his closest placed finishes have been in five-furlong contests.

ATR VERDICT: It is hard to weigh up Boitron on his Irish debut for a shrewd stable. He hasn't been seen since May 2019 and the previous month was only 9/4 for the Italian 2000 Guineas in which he finished last of the nine runners. Among his back form is a fourth in a Group One and a Listed success. If he performs anywhere near his rating he should stroll home but the lay-off of over 500 days would be a concern. He could make the market for an each-way play on TRUEBA who goes well for 7lb claimer Nikita Amelia Kane. His third in the Curragh looks decent form as the winner and fifth home both won their next starts. For The Trees takes a drop in class. Less than a year ago she won the Birdcatcher Premier Nursery at Naas. This season hasn't gone to plan but she could easily bounce back to form in this company.

Coming off a break and with a hood fitted for the first-time, the Zoffany gelding gets the vote in an open-looking maiden. Caldwell shaped well on debut when third at Bellewstown and the second has won since, while Tashi came home well at Navan and is another to consider. Pin Your Hopes had been consistent until a poor run last time and blinkers are fitted, but Delta Dawn might need this first outing in over a year. The 7-year-old Pike County ran well at Limerick and wouldn't be a forlorn hope by any means.

ATR VERDICT: PASO DOBLE was a surprise winner on seasonal debut at Roscommon and he can follow up off a 9lb higher mark. The drop to this trip may not be ideal, but Kevin Manning reported after that victory that the Dawn Approach colt has done well physically and is the type to keep improving. Kipling and Taramansour cut no ice in a Premier Handicap at the Curragh on Champions' Weekend but have to be respected back in shallower waters. Chiricahua is still lightly-raced and may leave behind his disappointing handicap debut at Killarney, and former sprinter Gee Rex may continue to improve having won over a similar trip at Gowran. Last-gasp Naas winner Lafayette and Tipperary maiden winner Longbourn are others open to more progression in a very competitive event.
