ATR VERDICT: WINDSOR PASS was fancied when fading to sixth at the Curragh, finishing well behind Friendly, when both fillies made their debuts back in June. After a break, the daughter of Lope De Vega was much better next time against colts back at headquarters when fourth to the smart Van Gogh. The Harrington yard is motoring along very nicely and Shane Foley's mount can get off the mark on her third outing. Friendly was ridden forward when placed on her next two starts before being disappointing at Dundalk. She obviously has her chance if bouncing back from that. Zumoradda was a place in front of a below-par Friendly in what was a hot maiden on the polytrack (subsequent Listed winner Fantasy Lady was the runner-up) and the Awtaad filly could be a player if improving a little more.

ATR VERDICT: Formerly a Southwell specialist during his time in Britain, Angel Palanas was a shrewd purchase by Pat Murphy and completed a hat-trick of handicap wins at Leopardstown on Saturday. He's basically done his job already for the Castlecomer handler and the November Sales were mentioned in the aftermath of that latest win. The Mayson gelding, understandably, comes here for what looks a good opportunity but it might be relevant that he hasn't shown his best going right-handed. We'll take him on with MARMOLATA, who's been a bit too keen over hurdles but had form at this trip last year. Stablemates Tony The Gent (best on a sound surface) and Lincoln (best at 6f) have chances but some doubts hanging over them as well, while Dark Magic looks the best of his trainer's five runners.

ATR VERDICT: The veteran COUNT OF CARABASS tends to up his game from September onwards and can strike here. Last month he finished a close fourth at Limerick and then he was caught close home when beaten a neck on heavy ground at the same track earlier this month. Five of his six career victories have come in autumn months. Sagittarius Rising has finished third in his last couple of handicaps. Colin Keane has been booked and his mount has a victory on testing ground from Gowran Park in his locker. He has to rate a threat. Ben Kennedy rode his first winner on Swiss Army Officer at Cork last week and the pair are reunited again. They have prospects of following up off 5lb higher. The form of Born Invincible's Limerick success is working out well. He wasn't at his best when next seen in the Curragh but could bounce back.

ATR VERDICT: Today could finally be the day for GLOW WORM. There is a deluge of rain expected before racing in Fairyhouse and she looks best placed to handle testing ground. She is a 20-race maiden but to her credit she has been placed no less than 11 times. Jack Davison's filly came in runner-up on soft ground at both Navan and Roscommon. Luke McAteer's 5lb claim is a bonus. Seven Worlds has a string of 'duck eggs' to his name but he may run better than his odds would imply. He has snippets of form on testing conditions including behind the progressive Champers Elysees in a valuable auction race at the Curragh. On his last start, he was unplaced in Navan but was beaten just over three and a half lengths. New headgear is tried on Cool Vixen, Royal Hideaway and Is That Love to try and eke out a bit more from them.

ATR VERDICT: ENTER THE RED just loves it when the mud is flying and holds strong claims. He has been runner-up in his last two races on testing ground and had no less than four subsequent winners behind him at Limerick. The 11-year-old isn't showing signs of slowing down. Pretty Smart won when last seen in Navan this month and the form got a boost when the third home then delivered in the Curragh. She has won over six furlongs in Dundalk but it is worth noting that her best turf results have come over five furlongs. Her trainer commented after that Navan win that she probably will get six furlongs now as she isn't as hard on herself as she used to be. Bellick knows how to win but deep ground isn't ideal for him.

ATR VERDICT: LOUDEST WHISPER won over course and distance on her last start and can follow up. It's not going to be easy as she is up 9lb in the weights and doesn't have a claimer reducing her burden this time. However, she is in form, will relish the ground and jockey Conor Maxwell has been on several times before. Indeed, the pair have been placed in their last three runs when teamed up together. High Lake (also engaged to run at Gowran on Monday) may prove to be the biggest threat on this ground. Her second place in a two-mile handicap on soft ground at Thurles earlier in the month is noted and she is less exposed than most.

ATR VERDICT: Shumaker is two from two around here and arrives off the back of a victory in a beginners' chase at Punchestown. He has handled attritional ground before but isn't enamoured with it. THEFAITHFULINDIAN was a ready winner by four and a half lengths at the Curragh last Thursday and makes plenty of appeal running off the mandatory 6lb penalty.
