ATR VERDICT: GIUSEPPE CASSIOLI got off the mark at the fourth attempt at Lingfield nine days ago and could be worth following for Charlie Hills. ATR VERDICT: Prominent racers are often rewarded here but it is entirely possible that Mr Wagyu and recent Kempton runner-up Enthaar will do too much bidding for the early lead.
