ATR VERDICT: EYLARA hails from a family that Dermot Weld has done well with in the past including Group 2 winner Eziyra, and the daughter of Gleneagles made a promising debut when beating all bar Talacre at Gowran Park last month. That looks solid form as the mile event has already thrown up a couple of winners and hopefully she can handle this softer surface. There are plenty of well-bred newcomers in opposition including Glinting, a sister to five winners who all stayed well including the useful Bondi Beach and Constantinople. Stay Safe has a speedier pedigree being a half-sister to six-furlong Listed winner Letters Of Note.

ATR VERDICT: HOROSCOPE caught the eye on debut behind better-fancied stable companion Khartoum over this trip at the Curragh earlier this month, and this looks a good opportunity to open his account. The No Nay Never colt took a long time to warm to his task but really got going inside the final furlong and it would be no surprise if he stepped forward significantly from that experience. Sword Zorro is the obvious threat. The Jessica Harrington-trained colt has put in four consistent runs on varying ground conditions, notably making the running when only going down by a length to subsequent Dewhurst Stakes runner-up Wembley on testing ground at Roscommon.

ATR VERDICT: AMBER KITE won a fillies' maiden with cut in the ground at Gowran Park back in July, and the daughter of exciting first-season sire New Bay showed she is off a competitive mark when beating all bar hot-favourite Magnanimous in a Cork nursery last month. The selection didn't enjoy much luck in running last Sunday behind stablemate Ecliptical in the valuable Foran Equine Auction Race Final at Naas. Tullypole Annie got off the mark on her third attempt in handicap company at the Curragh last month, and races off a feather weight here with her rider's claim. It will be interesting to note if there is any support for either Sheer Chance or Bondi Dreams who both get in off a mid 70s rating after three maiden runs. Star Image won a Curragh nursery over this trip and has kept some top company since including in the Moyglare.

ATR VERDICT: REVERBERATION progressed really well from a basement mark to score three times earlier this season including over a mile at this venue. The Jimmy Lambe-trained gelding went close subsequently here off a revised rating, and again shaped well after a break over course and distance last week when finishing well to beat all bar the progressive Angel Palanas. Sam Ewing again claims a valuable 7lb. Day Dreamin' benefitted from a change of tactics on the same card when making virtually all over a mile under Colin Keane and rates an obvious threat despite a 6lb hike. Madaket Mystery also shaped with promise here last Friday, while Tresorier, Kodiac Prince and Strange Times are others to consider in a competitive heat.

ATR VERDICT: REVE DE VOL gets a tentative vote. The Siyouni colt is the first that Ger Lyons has trained for Moyglare Stud and made a successful start when getting a Fairyhouse maiden in the stewards room. He's been highly-tried since and showed good reserves of stamina when staying in into third behind Cadillac and Van Gogh in a Group 2 over a mile at this venue. He holds Wuqood on running behind High Definition in the Beresford Stakes at the Curragh last time. It will be interesting to see how strong Carlisle Bay is in the market as the Galileo colt is thrown straight into Group company after making most to land a Tipperary maiden on debut. Flying Visit is being kept busy but is holding his form well.

ATR VERDICT: HELVIC DREAM was so impressive in the Group Three International Stakes at the Curragh last time and he's up to a rating of 110 now. The O'Briens - Joseph with three and Aidan with two - are strongly represented, but they'll all have to go something to match Helvic Dream if he turns up here in the same form as he did at HQ nearly a fortnight back. There is no reason to suggest that he won't, and as a three-year-old there could be even more to come from the selection. Noel Meade's string continues in rattling good order, and though there's a danger of horses going over the top at this time of year, this Power gelding didn't appear to take too much out of himself when defeating Up Helly Aa by no less than seven and a half lengths on October 11th. Second in a Group Two last time, Amma Grace is another that needs to be seriously considered.

ATR VERDICT: The reserves are a batch of three-year-olds, and it's worth waiting to see if any of these make the line-up as the potential for progression is definitely there amongst the 'subs.' Tony Martin and Sheila Lavery are both two-handed, and it's interesting to note that the latter's reserve, Chimeric, is a half-brother to Denis Hogan contender, Garrison Commander. DARE TO FLARE may not have won the races that his ability suggests he should have, but a third career success might come his way now. Back from hurdling with a visor on could be an opportune time to catch the Slattery runner. Many enter the equation, horses such as The Names Jock, Sharp Focus, Magic Chegaga and Kosman definitely noted.
