ATR VERDICT: PRAXEOLGY outran 50-1 odds to finish second here earlier in the month and the booking of Hollie Doyle looks significant off just 1lb higher. The three-year-old can clearly win off this sort of mark on that evidence, and although his price will be much shorter this time, could be worth another chance. Lord Oberon was fourth in a competitive 0-95 event at Haydock last time and won't mind this step up to 7f, while Byron's Choice likes it here and caught the eye when third at Ayr four weeks ago.
