ATR VERDICT: Black Sparrow has some interesting form to her name, though it was disappointing that she failed to justify favouritism when only third at Wolverhampton. Perfect Sign was second in a better race than this at Newcastle two starts ago and would be dangerous if back to that sort of level, but that isn't assured and a more solid option might be CAPLA DREAM. Second behind a more experienced rival here three weeks ago, those exertions will have done her good and the drop from 7f is a further positive.

Ron Thompson's charge remains relatively unexposed over this distance and is taken to defy a 2lb rise now under Shane Gray. Notation showed potential in two starts last season but has a 391-day absence to overcome, while Stone Mason could bounce back following a modest display at Nottingham earlier in the month.

ATR VERDICT: Ivaquestion was a shock 80-1 winner at Kempton and, given his overall profile, it is fair to suggest that a repeat seems unlikely. Redshank shaped better than his finishing position suggested at Wolverhampton last week, but this can go the way of BEAT THE HEAT. Fifth over 2m on Polytrack when last seen, Jim Boyle's three-year-old was previously successful at Lingfield and Nottingham over this distance and could resume his progression under Charlie Bennett.

ATR VERDICT: SEA OF MYSTERY returned to form when only finding an improving three-year-old too good at Chelmsford, and can claim compensation here for Mick Appleby. An unchanged mark of 65 gives this experienced type a chance, and we know that he handles the surface being a C&D winner. Thawry was beaten at odds-on here recently and has a further 6lb rise to try and defy now. Urban Spirit and Lucky Robin are both worthy of market checks.
