**ATR VERDICT:** CADEAU D'OR was a career-best third at Ascot earlier this month, relishing the step up in distance for Andrew Balding, and could take a further step forward now trying even further. The three-year-old wasn't far behind the 100-rated Tyson Fury on that occasion, enjoying the soft ground, and could have too much for Ispahan, who finished fourth in a competitive race at York recently but might need to be produced a bit earlier this time. Push The Tempo was fourth in the Silver Trophy at Chepstow last time and makes some appeal back on the level.
