ATR VERDICT: Flying West is developing nicely and backed up her Wolverhampton triumph when overcoming trouble at Yarmouth. She is up another 5lb and while that shouldn't be too much of a problem, she is passed over in favour of ESPRESSO FREDDO, who confirmed his 25/1 Hamilton second was no fluke when going one better at Windsor. Robert Stephens gets him out under a penalty before the assessor takes revenge, and the move can be rewarded. Sword Beach has been running well in defeat and might do so again.

ATR VERDICT: ZAPPER CASS is more effective on the all-weather, especially the Southwell Fibresand, but that is reflected by his significantly lower turf figure and he looked ready to capitalise on it when runner-up at Catterick recently. Michaels Choice burst back into life at Bath when paired with Tom Marquand for the first time, and the partnership remains intact. Rasheeq has hit the crossbar the last twice and his turn shouldn't be far away. Afandem didn't get the rub of the green at Musselburgh and that effort is best forgotten.
