ATR VERDICT: KOMACHI was three lengths adrift of the useful winner Oo De Lally when third at Kempton on debut, but that was a respectable display against more experienced rivals and there could be plenty more to come from the Kingman colt, who cost 625,000 guineas as a yearling. Expect To Succeed was a long way behind the aforementioned Oo De Lally when making his debut at Newbury, but is another six-figure buy who could be an improver. 
