ATR VERDICT: Those with experience don't set a daunting standard, with Southwell runner-up Sweet Bertie probably the best of them, so it might be best to concentrate on the newcomers. Charlie Appleby has an excellent record with his juvenile runners so far this year and his LAW OF NATURE, a 240,000-euro purchase who is a half-brother to Group 3 two-year-old winner Devant, could be the answer. Dubawi Sands looks to be Roger Varian's main hope, while William Haggas is also double-handed with Substantial and Alanmar.

ATR VERDICT: Ropey Guest comes out best at these weights and warrants respect, but he had a hard enough race over 1m on soft ground at Ascot 13 days ago and connections now feel the need to fit cheekpieces. Ainsdale is mightily consistent and looks sure to run well, but a chance is taken on LAMPANG. This unexposed son of Dandy Man impressed as a juvenile, winning two of his three starts, and is entitled to improve for his comeback third over 5f at Musselburgh earlier this month. Ventura Lightning has undergone wind surgery since he was last sighted and completes a small but select field.

ATR VERDICT: KINDRED SPIRIT pounced late to run down Glesga Gal (second) with ease at Yarmouth on debut and Roger Varian's filly looks to have a touch of class as she takes her chance at this level. The daughter of Invincible Spirit relished the testing conditions on that occasion and is out of a two-year-old Group 3 winner over this distance. The hat-trick seeking Mishal Star is improving all the time and looks capable of a big performance, while any further rainfall won't bother Ventura Diamond or Worldly Wise, who both won on heavy ground last time.

ATR VERDICT: WATER'S EDGE has been in top form this season and has thrived with cut in the ground most recently, notching up back-to-back Windsor victories. He is turned out relatively quickly under a 5lb penalty and attempts to make hay while conditions remain in the four-year-old's favour. The form of Kryptos' recent Nottingham second was franked when the winner followed up at Newbury at the weekend and the six-year-old makes plenty of appeal off the same mark. Croeso Cymraeg ran better than the bare result would suggest when fifth last time and his form before that is very encouraging, while the veteran Awake My Soul can't be ignored.

ATR VERDICT: CHANCE has rattled the crossbar in some competitive contests the last twice and with the form of both those races looking strong, Simon & Ed Crissford's four-year-old has a great chance of landing a deserved victory here.
