**ATR VERDICT:** Falco Blitz and Republican certainly weren't disgraced when fifth and sixth respectively behind recent Persian War winner McFabulous in a Grade 3 hurdle at Kempton in March and they both warrant respect switching to fences for the first time. However, with both a recent run and chase experience under his belt, DR SANDERSON looks the one to beat. He was impressive when making a winning return at Plumpton earlier this month and a 7lb rise might not be enough to anchor him if arriving in the same mood.
