ATR VERDICT: BLACK CORTON enjoyed a consistent last season despite not getting his head in front placing in three big handicaps, including in this contest 12 months ago when third to Vinndication, and carried top weight on each occasion. The nine-year-old faces a stiff task once again but a wind operation might eke out some improvement and a bold display is expected with the trainer/jockey combination hoping for similar to last Saturday after Frodon's victory at Cheltenham. Commanche Red is open to further improvement on just his fifth outing over fences and his nine-length beating of Simply The Betts at Kempton on Boxing Day reads particularly well. Whatmore, who was last seen finishing fourth at the Cheltenham Festival, is respected along with Valtor, who boasts a decent record at the track, and course specialist Regal Encore, who also received wind surgery over the summer.
