





**ATR VERDICT:** CAVALRY SCOUT had been knocking on the door at Market Rasen before dropping back to a similar distance to land a deserved victory at Leicester in February and rates as the one to beat on his seasonal bow. He was all out at the finish on that occasion but relishes testing conditions and the track is likely to suit. Roxboro Road has dropped to his last winning mark and is worth a market check as he's still in the early stages of his career with Ben Haslam. The handicapper looks to have the measure of both Calivigny and Mah Mate Bob, but the experienced pair know how to win and can't be completely ruled out, while Lucinda Russell has a solid hand with Katalystic and Book Of Invasions.
