ATR VERDICT: There will be plenty expected of SIR GERHARD here given the horses Gordon Elliott has won this with in recent years. Malone Road carried the same Cheveley Park colours to a stunning success in the race two years ago so it looks significant that the Jeremy gelding comes here in a bid to give the yard a sixth straight win in the contest. Sir Gerhard looked a smart prospect when winning his sole point-to-point start and made £400,000 at the sales last December. Patrick Mullins is an interesting booking for Gavin Cromwell's charge Vintage Prosseco. He fell six from home on his sole point-to-point run when making the running and well clear. The Banger Doyle has been placed on both starts to date and might be able to reach the frame again.
