**ATR VERDICT:** QUILIXIOS has won both starts over hurdles (the first of them in France back in March) very easily and is hard to oppose. He gave 12lb and a 13-length beating to previous winner Scholastic on his first Irish outing at Punchestown earlier this month. His trainer has enjoyed a lot of success in this category already this autumn and also provides the main danger in Glorious Zoff. One couldn't find fault with the way he won on hurdling debut at Sligo and it'll be interesting how he copes up in class and on softer ground. Paul Flynn thinks dual Flat winner Na Caith Tobac will make a useful hurdler but his charge faces a stiff task even in receipt of weight.

**ATR VERDICT:** It's a brave, and possibly foolish, shout to oppose the likely short-priced favourite but COLONEL MUSTARD is a horse of some potential in his own right. Lorna Fowler's Flat-bred gelding was beaten by a subsequent Listed bumper winner on debut and then won nicely at Punchestown. He's obviously unproven over flights but, solely on bumper form, you can make a case for him. Ballyadam cost plenty after winning a point-to-point but was turned over at 1/4 on his racecourse debut by subsequent Cheltenham bumper seventh Julies Stowaway. He then duly obliged at Downpatrick when winning very easily but he had little to beat there. He's obviously an exciting novice hurdling prospect. Useful Flat horse Still Standing went close on his third hurdles start at Gowran but has more to do here, while Hes A Hardy Bloke is a point-to-point and bumper winner from a top yard and looked a nice type when winning at Clonmel.

**ATR VERDICT:** The coming few months will tell us how strong last season's crop of juveniles were but, in any event, WOLF PRINCE looks to have a good profile for this first run in open handicap hurdle company. He was a dual winner and Grade 1-placed last term and had a nice prep for this when third on the Flat at Gowran recently. Testing ground won't be a problem for him. The ultra-consistent Getaway Gorgeous was touched off by Drop The Anchor at Listowel but on overall form is preferred to that rival, while Golden Jewel had a couple of very good runs at Leopardstown last season and should be better for a recent run. One who goes well fresh is Thereisnodoubt and, even though he's gone up a lot in the ratings, he could get involved. Cayd Boy is another who has won off a lay-off and he might be the best of the five in the green and gold, while Golden Spear hasn't won since landing this prize in 2018 but has put in some encouraging runs on the Flat this year.

ATR VERDICT: PRESENTING PERCY is held by his new stablemate Delta Work on several formlines but maybe Gordon Elliott will have worked his magic to get the nine-year-old back to winning ways. It hasn't worked out for the former top-class novice in open company yet, but he was only a few lengths behind Delta Work on a couple of occasions last season and has shown in the past that he's well capable of winning after an absence. Delta Work is a five-time Grade 1 winner over fences and very much the one to beat. For some reason he was below-par on his reappearance in this race last year but went on to land two big prizes at Leopardstown before finishing a creditable, if slightly disappointing, fifth in the Gold Cup when last seen. Chris's Dream was impressive in winning his first two starts last season before being seemingly outclassed in the Gold Cup. He's only had six chase starts though, and there might still be more to come from him. The Storyteller has been typically well placed in recent months but is likely to struggle in this company.

**ATR VERDICT:** PARANOID won on his first outing for Gordon Elliott at Galway earlier in the month and may be able to strike again here switched to fences. He had to work to get home by a neck at Ballybrit but stepping up in trip now may help. He had some decent runs in hot beginners chases and this mark of 112, 2lb more than he had over hurdles recently, looks one he can win off. Touch Of Oscar has run well in novice company on his last couple of starts and back in a handicap now he shouldn't be far away. Coeur Joyeux remains on the same mark as when a solid third at Punchestown last time and could get involved at the finish again.

**ATR VERDICT:** There will be plenty expected of SIR GERHARD here given the horses Gordon Elliott has won this with in recent years. Malone Road carried the same Cheveley Park colours to a stunning success in the race two years ago so it looks significant that the Jeremy gelding comes here in a bid to give the yard a sixth straight win in the contest. Sir Gerhard looked a smart prospect when winning his sole point-to-point start and made £400,000 at the sales last December. Patrick Mullins is an interesting booking for Gavin Cromwell's charge Vintage Prosseco. He fell six from home on his sole point-to-point run when making the running and well clear. The Banger Doyle has been placed on both starts to date and might be able to reach the frame again.
