The Frankel filly is certainly bred to have plenty of ability, being a full-sister to multiple Group 1 winner Cracksman, and it will be disappointing if she isn't there or thereabouts. Mobadra and Mused are other names to note.

ATR VERDICT: If TURNTABLE can recapture something like his best form in a first-time hood, he will go very close. The Pivotal gelding has dropped to a mark just 3lb higher than when he secured back-to-back victories here in July and, relatively lightly raced for his age, he ticks plenty of boxes and might be on offer at a generous price. ATR VERDICT: Mystery Angel has experience on her side and ran on well for third in the Zetland over 10 furlongs here earlier in the month. That is good form, but over this trip at Pontefract last time she shaped as though she wanted further, despite only narrowly losing out in Listed company. It could be that she finds one or two too sharp for her over a mile and the less-exposed ALBA ROSE might appreciate going up in distance after she shaped with promise in the Group 2 Rockfel Stakes over 7f, staying on at the one pace for third. Teodolina is another to take seriously, likewise the unbeaten Zeyaadah, who beat Mystery Angel on debut at Chelmsford and has since won easily at Beverley under a penalty.

ATR VERDICT: This is all about HEADMAN, a dual Group 2 winner last year who hasn't been seen since disappointing on his reappearance in the Prices Of Wales's Stakes at Royal Ascot in June. Not beaten far when fifth of eight in the Irish Champion Stakes behind Magical last season, Roger Charlton's inmate looks extremely well treated in such company and won't need to run right up to his rating of 115 to win. If he did, it would take a career-best performance for the 109-rated Marie's Diamond to stop him giving him 3lb, although Mark Johnston's colt is put forward as the main danger dropping into Listed company for the first time since winning easily here in June. His stablemate Freyja is progressive and will go on the ground, while Be More has plenty to find on official figures but should run her usual honest race. Air Pilot was well beaten in this 12 months ago but is another who will enjoy the underfoot conditions.

ATR VERDICT: ASPIRATION is the most unexposed runner in the field after just three starts for Martyn Meade and could double her career tally under Tom Marquand. The three-year-old was successful on heavy ground at Yarmouth recently after a three-month break and could have more to offer back over 7f on her handicap debut.
