ATR VERDICT: FROW has won three in a row on artificial surfaces, including over C&D the last twice, and could defy an 8lb rise with Ray Dawson's claim negotiating plenty of that damage. The four-year-old will be suited by a low draw in stall two, and is taken to prevail ahead of recent Chelmsford runner-up Rockesbury, who will probably be handed a positive ride by Luke Morris. Doctor Nuno was second behind the selection on stable debut for Tony Carroll recently and also makes some appeal.
