











Beatbybeatbybeat went close at Newcastle last time and has a fine record here, while Kenstone finished ahead of that rival when they last met at this venue and arrives in good order. John Mackie's Hurricane Ali is also considered having made the podium off this mark over track and trip last week, with the handler's string running well of late.
