

ATR VERDICT: HASTY SAILOR shaped with promise on his second career outing when fourth over C&D in August and a wind operation, combined with a first-time tongue tie, may see Sir Michael Stoute's gelding improve considerably. Licit returned to form when second at Kempton earlier in the month and she can enter calculations along with Pledge Of Peace, who appeals on his handicap debut.
